Aligarh College has completed 22 years of Academic Excellence spreading quality education and making a extraordinary contributions in the field of Education as one of the most renowned college in the city. The college has kept pace with the changing world and has been the pioneer behind many innovations in the field of education thus acquiring a well-deserved reputation in academics, sports and co-curricular activities.

**OVERVIEW OF THE INSTITUTION:**

There are two colleges functioning in this campus mainly Aligarh College of Engineering and Management (ACEM) and Aligarh College of Education (ACE), both the Colleges have been established under the aegis of Crescent Charitable Trust (CCT) an NGO founded in 1988 for charitable and educational purposes by some enthusiastic teachers of Aligarh Muslim University.

## **HISTORY:**

In 1998, Dr. Manzoor Ahmad, Ex-Vice-Chancellor, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University, Agra visited AMU. On this occasion he reminded the mission of Sir Syed Ahmad Khan that asked the audience to develop higher education institutions in India. On his motivation and encouragement, the council of Trustees of Charitable Trust decided to start a College at Aligarh. The Aligarh College of Engineering and Management was given affiliation by the Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University, Agra and two courses BBA and BCA were launched in 1999, with the intake of 30 and 60 respectively, in Sultan Building, Medical Road, Dodhpur, Aligarh. Later on, in 2003 the campus of the College was constructed and some new courses were added such as MBA, MCA affiliated to the G.J. University, Hissar and Diploma in Engg., B.Tech. in Civil, Computer and Electronics Engineering were affiliated to RVD University, Udaipur. However, these courses were closed because of Government policy in 2011.

In the 2008-2009 session, B.Ed. course was introduced in Aligarh College of Education with the intake of 100 students, the Aligarh College of Education offered some new courses such as BA with seven subjects, B.Com, B.Sc. with five subjects and B.Sc. (Biotechnology), in 2017 a new course D.EL.ED, (formerly known as BTC) was introduced. And in the current session we have introduced Master courses such as MA/MCOM/and Msc

We conducted a D.EL.ED examination of 500 students in 2019.

And the NIOS D.EL.ED examination of 497 students.

This year we received approval for conducting CTET Entrance.
