History and Description of Aligarh College of Education:

ACE was established with keeping in view the dream of Sir Syed Ahmed Khan. In 1998, Dr. Manzoor Ahmed, the former Vice-Chancellor of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University, Agra, visited Aligarh Muslim University. While addressing the audience, he reminded them of mission of Sir Syed Ahmed Khan and beseeched them to develop more higher institutions throughout India for minorities and women students. Motivated by his speech, the council of trustees of the Crescent Charitable Trust decided to start a college in Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh.

Aligarh is an Industrial and Educational hub famous for its Lock Industries and Aligarh Muslim University (AMU). It provides employment to the people from all the states of India. It is a melting pot so far as people from various states, cultures, traditions and languages are living together. So, it was the best place to start a new college.

The college campus is located at Anoopshahar Road, KasimpurTiraha, Chherat. It is 8 kms away from railway station and 5 kms from the Jamalpur flyover bridge. The Anoopshahar Road is well connected with the Delhi high way through a by-pass road. The campus is built on a plot of 12 acres of land. It is accessible by local and inter city regular bus services. The college buses and vans are also available for easy transportation.

In the 2008-2009 session, B.Ed. course was introduced in Aligarh College of Education with the intake of 100 students. The Aligarh College of Education then started some new courses such as BA in 2014, with seven subjects, B.Com.in 2014, B.Sc. ZBC & PCM in 2015, B.Sc. Biotechnology in 2015 and D.El.Ed. in 2017.

Infrastructure:

Aligarh College of Education has a well-established infrastructure which is quite apt with the academic and extracurricular requirements of the students. There are around fifteen classrooms in the college that are well equipped with proper furniture, lighting and ventilation. There is also fully functional smart classroom available in the college, so that along with conventional chalk and talk method of teaching, teachers can also use digital mode for effective teaching.

The college campus has two buildings Alpha and Beta, with classrooms, labs, offices and washrooms catering to the needs of the students. Apart from this, the college has an auditorium, to help ICT enabled teaching-learning programs. College library has a rich collection of books, journals and magazines to meet the changing demand so fuser community. Facility of computer labs with good internet connectivity is provided to the students. College also has Wi-Fi facility and CCTV cameras installed.

Separate common room for girls with separate washrooms, auditorium, canteen, open air theatre a large play ground are some of the essential features of the college campus.

Physical Education and Sports Department:

Aligarh College of Education has well established sports grounds. A large playground, basket ball court, badminton court etc. are the most essential features of the college campus. Various indoor & outdoor games, like Table Tennis, Carom, Chess, Cricket, Football, Basket ball, Badminton and Basket ball, are played by students.

Teaching-Learning:

Aligarh College of Education has up-to-date and latest IT Infrastructure to support the teaching & learning processes. Different ICT equipment like Scanners, Printers, LCD Projectors, Wi-Fi modems, Speakers etc. are available in the College, for making teaching-learning process more effective.

The College has planned programs to provide exposure and to enhance the students' learning experience by student-centric methods like, field trips, practice teaching in schools, case-studies, action research, and project-based learning and group discussions. In addition to that, seminars, workshops, guest lectures/invited talks are also arranged for students from time to time.

In the teaching-learning process, cognitive & psychomotor domains are focused. The students learn through video lectures, demonstrations, quizzes, assignments, presentations etc. To enhance understanding and problem-solving ability, students are encouraged to undertake projects and internship in schools and other colleges, to have a better understanding of the work environment.

The faculty Development Program and several other need-based awareness programs, training, seminars and workshops have been arranged from time to time for students, teaching Faculty and non-teaching staff. Colleges always encourage the faculty to publish their creative output in various National and International Journals.
