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Aligarh city is located on the main Delhi-Kolkata railway link and Grand Trunk Road, approximately 140 km southeast of the capital city,

New Delhi, and 91 km from Agra city. It is very well connected with the major cities of India by railways and roads. Aligarh is mainly known for being the seat of Aligarh Muslim University, having a unique heritage, and being an example of Indo-Islamic culture. The other popular landmarks are Aligarh Fort, Jama Masjid, Khereshwar Temple, the birthplace of Swami Shri Haridas Ji, etc. The city is also famous for its lock industry and is nicknamed the "city of locks" (Taala Nagri). The weather in Aligarh is mostly pleasant (25-35°C) with monsoon starting in late June continuing until early October followed by winters.





Aligarh College of Education (ACE) is located on NH-509, Chherat, 10 km from the Aligarh Junction. It was established by Crescent Charitable Trust, Aligarh founded by Prof. M. Muqim with the vision of providing quality education to the deprived and underprivileged class of the society, under NEP initiative of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi. The college was established in 1999 in an

area of 12 acres, it has influenced society with its excellent management system and well-qualified and dedicated faculty having qualifications from top Indian and foreign universities. Since its inception, the ACE primarily focused on language, discipline, soft skills, leadership qualities, moral values and personality development of students and staff. As per the needs of society, the ACE offers 13 undergraduate and three postgraduate programs and is poised to introduce four new programs from the coming session 2025-26. The college is declared a minority institution playing a vital role in uplifting society.
